Interdisciplinary Lecture Series of the Faculty of Humanities: The City - Culture-led Regeneration: Space - Knowledge - Participation

09.04.2024 - In the summer semester 2024, >PD Dr. Nora Pleßke (https://www.ang.ovgu.de/ifph/en/Plesske-p-818.html) and her team frc the transSCAPE: Cultural Spaces of Knowledge project, part of the TransPORT transfer initiative for the transformation of the Pc of Science, are organising the interdisciplinary lecture series at the Faculty of Humanities (Building 44, Lecture Hall 6, Zschokkestraße 32) every Tuesday from 5:00pm to 7:00pm. Under the title "The City - Culture-led Regeneration: Space - Knowledge - Participation", the lecture series will feature experts from the fields of history, political and social sciences, cultural studies, literature and linguistics as well as philosophy, geography, architecture and art, who will examine and critically discuss culture-led regeneration from various disciplinary perspectives. The lecture series invites participants to discuss the challenges and potentials of culture-led regeneration in cities and to provide new impetus for participatory and future-oriented urban development. PD Dr Nora Pleßke opens lecture series "The World of Things: Insights into Science, History, Theory and Practice"

03.04.2024 - As part of the project "One University, One Book", OVGU is organising a lecture series in the summer semester 20 entitled > "The World of Things: Insights into Science, History, Theory and Practice" (https://www.ovgu.de/-p-138356.html), which > PD Dr. Nora Pleßke (https://www.ang.ovgu.de/ifph/en/Plesske-p-818.html) will open on 18 April 2024 at 6 p.m. in the Senate Hall (Building 0: Room 205) with a lecture on "The Great Victorian Collection' and the Translocation of Colonial Objects". In her habilitation thesis Nora Pleßke investigated the transformative influence of products from colonial territories perceived as 'foreign', the appropriatio of exotic objects and the commercialisation of colonial objects, and these epistemological changes will also be the focus of the lecture. Using the example of the Great Exhibition, the concept of translocation for postcolonial studies of material culture will firs be introduced in order to then trace the complex processes of appropriation of colonial objects in new (everyday) networks of meaning. > Other lectures (https://www.ang.ovgu.de/ifph_media/Hinterlegte+PDFs/Vorlesungsreihe_Welt_der_Dinge_Flyer-p-1268.pdf) will deal w computer and video games, post-digital materiality, object biographies, provenance research on property looted by the Nazis and cyclographic narratives.
